Who appoints a data protection officer in Albania?

Companies processing personal data must appoint a Data Protection Officer (if required). - Data breaches must be reported to the Albanian Information and Data Protection Commissioner. - Ministry of Finance and Economy - Oversees corporate governance and financial regulations.
