What is a battery fee?

Under the battery fee provisions, the term is defined as follows: "Those lead-acid batteries designed for use in motor vehicles, vessels, and aircraft, and includes such batteries when sold as a component part of a motor vehicle, vessel, or aircraft, but not when sold to recycle components."

What types of batteries are exempt from fees?

Batteries only suitable for motor cycles,off-road recreation vehicles or lawn and garden equipmentare exempt from the fees in this chapter. Definition: A battery containing lead and sulfuric acid that has a nominal voltage of at least six volts and is intended for use in motor vehicles.

How is lead-acid battery recycling regulated?

Lead-acid battery recycling in the United States is regulated by both federal and state authorities. BCI offers a state-by-state summary of battery recycling laws free of charge.
