Who owns the electricity supply industry in Zimbabwe?

The electricity supply industry (ESI) is dominated by government owned utility, namely Zimbabwe Electricity Supply Authority (ZESA) Holdings with its subsidiaries: Zimbabwe Power Company (ZPC) and Zimbabwe Electricity Transmission & Distribution Company (ZETDC).

Is Zimbabwe a good place to get electricity?

In general the power generation capacity in Zimbabwe is too small to meet demand from the industry and private householdings. Import of electricity from surrounding countries has eased the situation somewhat, but load shedding is used on a routine basis and some rural areas do not have electricity over long periods.

How much electricity does Zimbabwe produce?

About 50% of Zimbabwe's electricity demand is driven by the mining and other heavy industries. Despite having a vast renewable energy potential, 18 IPPs produce just about 136 MW of power for own consumption or for trading, out of which 36 MW is generated from Renewable sources.
